Exploring and developing ideas

Pupils should be taught to:

1. record from experience and imagination, to select and record from first-hand observation and to explore ideas for different purposes
2. question and make thoughtful observations about starting points and select ideas to use in their work.

Investigating and making art, craft and design

Pupils should be taught to:

1. use a variety of methods and approaches to communicate observations, ideas and feelings, and to design and make images and artefacts.

Evaluating and developing work

Pupils should be taught to:

1. compare ideas, methods and approaches in their own and others' work and say what they think and feel about them
2. adapt their work according to their views and describe how they might develop it further.

Breadth of study

During the key stage, pupils should be taught the Knowledge, skills and understanding through:

1. working on their own, and collaborating with others, on projects in two and three dimensions and on different scales.
