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# Diabetic Foot Ulcer Study

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## Have you been suffering from a diabetic foot ulcer for more than two and a half months?

If so, we would like to invite you to participate in our research study, looking into whether the healing of diabetic foot ulcers can be improved with the use of a product called the **RAPID™ Biodynamic Haematogel**. This product consists of a concentrated gel containing vitamin C and your body's own blood cells. This aims to boost natural healing processes, and ultimately improve wound healing.

This study will involve two groups of participants that are randomly assigned to either:

**Group 1:** Treatment with the **RAPID™ Biodynamic Haematogel** together with the usual best standard of care.

**Group 2:** Treatment with the usual best standard of care.

This will allow us to understand which treatment works better to assist wound healing.

Wound care will be performed with or without the **RAPID™ Biodynamic Haematogel** according to the treatment group you are allocated to.

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
